DRAW AN AFRICAN ELEPHANT

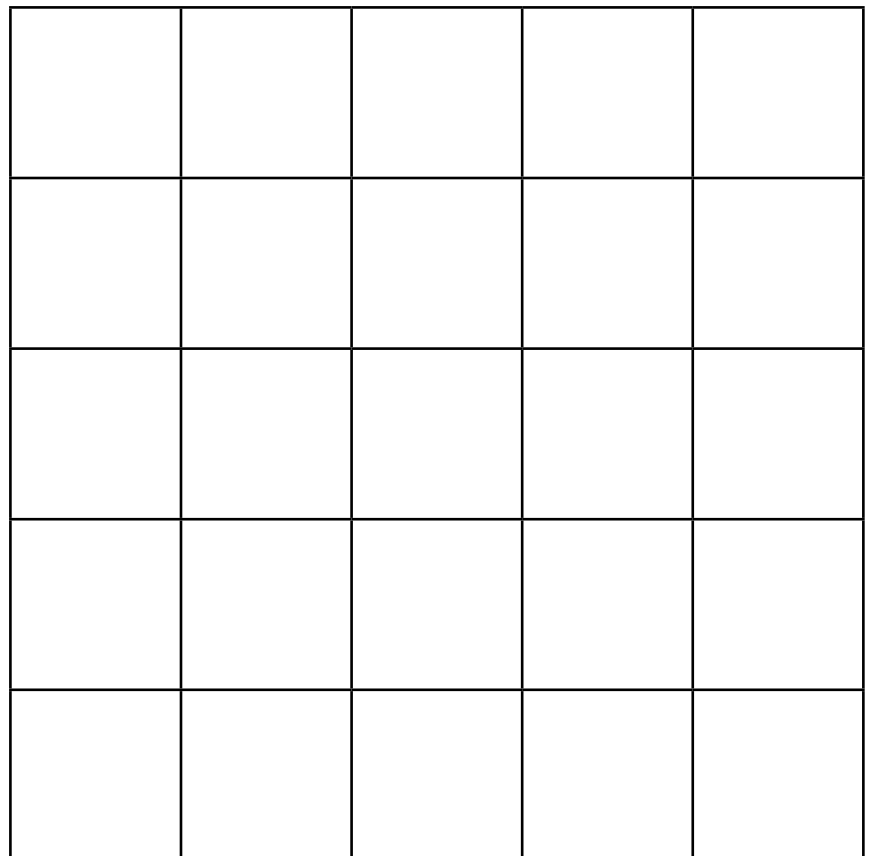
